

Pest Alert – Dollarweed



Dollarweed Facts:

- Dollarweed thrives in infertile soil where moisture is high
- Dollarweed reproduces through seeds, tubers and rhizomes in the lawn
- Using a broadleaf weed killer for lawns according to label directions can help reduce Dollarweed without harming grass
- *Dollarweed is also known as "Pennywort"*
- In planting beds, Dollarweed can be controlled by using a non-selective weed control like Kleenup® applied directly to the plant

Dollarweed Control in Lawns and Beds

Dollarweed is a perennial broad leafed weed which is common in warm season grasses. Dollarweed looks like a small lily pad, and will thrive in weak and infertile soils where the ground is wet. Because it reproduces several ways, controlling this weed is difficult, especially when the weed has been untreated for a season. If Dollarweed is a problem in your lawn be sure to reduce your irrigation frequency and duration.

Chemical controls for Dollarweed vary depending on where the weed is a problem. In lawns, the weed can be controlled by using a high quality selective lawn weed control such as Bonide Weed Beater Ultra, or Bonide Weed Beater Plus. Both products list Dollarweed on the label and offer full control in a variety of lawn types.

Dollarweed can be controlled in planting beds by applying glyphosate to weeds, being careful not to apply to desirable plants. Glyphosate is the active ingredient in Bonide Kleenup Grass and Weed Killer

Because of its extensive root system and the various ways that Dollarweed reproduces, multiple applications of weed control in lawns and in beds may be necessary. Be sure to read and follow the label directions carefully and pay attention to the temperature guidelines if applying in the summer.
