## Directions

1 pound equals approx. 3 cupfuls

### Soil Preparation

When preparing gardens for vegetables or tomatoes apply 5 lbs. of Garden-tone per 100 square feet (or 1 cup per 7 sq. ft.) and work into the top 4 to 5 inches of soil. When possible, organic matter such as compost, humus, or peatmoss should be mixed into the top 4 to 5 inches of soil.

### Vegetable Gardens

#### I. When to Feed

- **Seedlings:**  
Feed 1 week to 10 days after planting.

#### II. How Much to Feed

- **Single Plants:**  
1/4 cup per plant, once a month during growing season.
- **Rows:**  
1 cup to each side of 5 feet of row or 8 lbs. per 100 feet of row.

#### III. How to Apply

- Apply in a narrow band around single plants or along each side of row. Keep 3 inches away from plant stems.

### Tomatoes

Feed 1/4 cup of Garden-tone per tomato plant. After plants are established, feed monthly during the growing season.
